The Sunday divisions are as follows:

There being insufficient nominations in any age group, it was determined that each age group would be run as a single division. On review of the team numbers in G10 and G11, the decision was taken to run them as separate age groups.

The SSF Council will consider “promoting” the top two G10 teams to G11 and “relegating” the bottom two G11 to G10 after round 5. This will be the subject of discussion at the next SSF Council meeting. i.e. while the age groups are being run separately for the first 5 rounds of games, the possibility of running them as two divisions is still to be considered. The teams who have byes in each rounds of G10 and G11 will be scheduled to play each other outside the regular draw
