3. Grading of Teams.

Clubs had been issued with the proposed grading of teams based on the Nominations that had been received.

Noted that teams from Maccabi that will be playing on Sunday's were noted within the document.

Grade 12: Originally proposed as 4 divisions, however after review of teams that had been nominated and amended, it was agreed by clubs that there would be three (3) divisions of 8 teams each. This would also mean that a Championship and Pennant Final Series could be run in each division, should they remain this way till the end of the season.

Grade 13: Originally proposed as two divisions, however after review of teams that had been nominated and amendments made, it was agreed by clubs that ALL teams would play a complete round and once that had been completed teams would then be 're-graded' to appropriate divisions.

Grade 14: Originally proposed as two divisions, however an error in the compiled document showed that two divisions would no longer be possible as it would leave only 3 teams in Division 1. It was therefore agreed by clubs that ALL teams would play a complete round and once that had been completed teams would be 're-graded' to appropriate divisions. It was asked that teams which had been nominated in Division 1 not play the same opposition in consecutive weeks where possible.

Grade 15: With an amendment made to the original document due to a nomination error, it was agreed by clubs that Division 1 would consist of 6 teams and Division 2 would consist of 5 teams.

Grade 16: No amendments were required to this age group and it was agreed by clubs that Division 1 would consist of 6 teams, and Division 2 would consist of 4 teams.

Grade 17/18: There were no amendments to this age group and the division will consist of 8 teams.

15 March 2012 – FMC to ratify the gradings

16 March 2012 – Final Grading issue to clubs.

20 March 2012 – Objections to grading to be submitted by club.

22 March 2012 – FMC to hear objections

26 March 2012 – draw for 1st week issued.

3. General Business (from the floor):

Mascot Kings: Football NSW State and Sydney Cups nominations are due at the start of April and would like clubs to consider nominating their teams in this knock out competition. Games are played on Sunday, so very little impact to competition games and games are not every weekend.
ESFA to issue email to clubs advising and providing details.

East FC: Clarification required over process involved in having the 1 week automatic suspension of a player waived and under what circumstances this could occur.
ESFA to seek clarification from Football NSW in relation to this as there was nothing specific within rules.
